LEAGUE MEMBERSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS

All GTBBL Members must Review and Abide by the League RULES, REGULATIONS, and POLICIES, set forth in this document by the Gloucester Township Boys Basketball League Program. League Membership includes Coaching Staff, Players, Parents, and Spectators. Failure to do so may result in Sanctions or Expulsion from the GTBBL organization and all league Activities.

1. All Parents and Spectators attending GTBBL games or practices must remain on the Opposite Side of the Teams and or Scorer's Table in the Gyms. No one other than the Head Coaches, Assistant Coaches, and Officials at the Scorer's Table will be permitted on the Team's side of the Gym during games. Each Team is only permitted to have (1) Head Coach and (1) Assistant Coach that has been sanctioned by the GTBBL Board and assigned to that team.
2. Players, parents, coaches need to remain in control of themselves at all times. Head coaches are responsible for all team members (including staff and parents). Adults, especially coaches need to set a good example of proper conduct. Remember, you are playing against friends and neighbors from our own community. They are not the Enemy!
3. Players, Parents, and Coaches and there are encouraged to reasonably CHEER FOR a team, but NOT AGAINST anyone from the Opposing Team. Positive and constructive remarks are welcome Negative comments are not. Complaints may be forwarded to the Division Coordinators but should not be made in front of the children or other parents.
4. Parents or other Responsible Individuals will be asked to volunteer to assist our teams by working at the Scorer's Table to handle the Scoring Book and Game Clock prior to the start of each game. The Game will not start or be played if no volunteers step forward to assume these roles.
5. For Insurance Purposes, only GTBBL approved Facilities, Equipment, and Staff Personnel are permitted to conduct League Activities representing the GTBBL organization. Teams cannot meet or practice at any other location, or with any other group, or under anyone else's supervision, other than those provided and previously approved by GTBBL Board of Directors.
6. No one is permitted to interfere with school activities. Members cannot enter Gyms in School Facilities during weekdays until 6:30 PM and must vacate all Township Facilities by 9:00PM. Only facilities approved, scheduled, and assigned by the School District to GTBBL may be used. Approved Outside Facilities may be used and scheduled for weekends.
7. **NO FOOD, DRINKS, WATER BOTTLES, COFFEE CUPS, ETC. ARE PERMITTED IN THE GYM FACILITIES. THIS INCLUDES PARENTS AS WELL AS PLAYERS.** Only Water Fountains may be used. No smoking is permitted on school grounds in accordance with State Law. Each Coach is responsible to check the gym before a game starts. Also, all trash and any other items must be picked up and cleaned before a team's leave the Gyms for the evening.
8. Coaches are responsible for the proper securing of the gym at the end of the evening. All equipment must be put away and the gym left clean. A Team Representative should check the bathrooms. Everyone should be out of the school and all children picked.
Team Officials are responsible that no child is left behind or unsupervised at Facilities!
9. Team representative shall help with the scheduling of the parent monitor program. Each parent monitor, on their assigned date, shall be sure children are not running in hallways, using balls in hallways, destroying any property hanging in hallways, and that the bathrooms are used properly (i.e.: water not left running etc.)
10. All GTBBL members must adhere to all Township Facility Rules and to be courtesy to all Authorities responsible for the Safety and Use of Township Facilities.
